PICK DON'T PLUCK

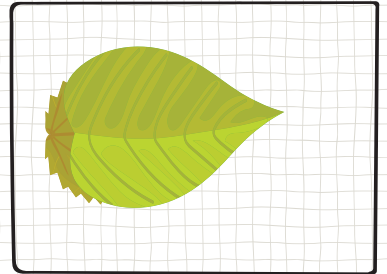


FOLLOW THESE STEPS

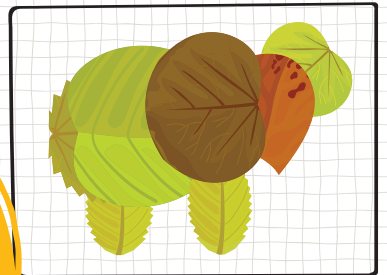
- 1 Go out and gather fallen leaves. Collect as many leaves in varying sizes, shapes and colours.



- 2 Use the largest leaf as the body and paste it on the drawing block using white glue.



- 3 Add on medium-sized leaves as its face, ears and legs. Glue these down firmly.



- 4 Save the smallest leaves to create the trunk and a pair of tusks. Secure them down with glue. And there you have it – an elephant! ♥
