


## **FOLLOW THESE STEPS**

Go out and gather fallen leaves.
Collect as many leaves in varying sizes, shapes and colours.



2 Use the largest leaf as the body and paste it on the drawing block using white glue.



3 Add on medium-sized leaves as its face, ears and legs. Glue these down firmly.



Save the smallest leaves to create the trunk and a pair of tusks.

Secure them down with glue. And there you have it — an elephant!
