# Branching Out

Bring a little bit of nature indoors with this DIY hanging mobile.

**Let Nature Inspire**  
**HEY PARENTS!** Turn this art project into an **outdoor scavenger hunt** by getting your child to look for **fallen leaves** from different plants and of **different shapes**. This is a fun activity that gets children to closely observe what's around them.

## Follow these steps

1. Place tracing paper or coloured paper over a leaf.



2. Rub crayon over the paper.



3. Do a few more leaf imprints using different leaves and different coloured crayons.



4. Cut out the leaves.



5. Punch a hole in each paper leaf, thread a piece of string through it and tie a knot.



6. Tie the other end of the string to the twig. Repeat for the other paper leaves. Vary the lengths of the strings.
