
$\rightarrow$ WHAT YOU'LL NEED


10 medium-sized pebbles or stones


Plain cardstock


Scissors


HEY PARENTS! Bring your child outdoors to look for small rocks or pebbles at the park, nature reserve or beach. Think of ways to recycle materials found at home (e.g., use buttons or bottle caps for game pieces; a small tin box or drawstring bag for the board; fabric scraps or washi tape for the grid pattern). To personalise the gift, your child can decorate the outside of the box or make a handmade Teachers' Day card.

TIP! Smooth, flat pebbles are ideal for painting. Wash to remove any soil or grit so that paint can adhere better.
2. Place a shoebox lid on a cardstock sheet. Trace the edges of the lid with a pencil and cut out the shape.

4. Glue the cardstock inside the shoebox lid. Let it dry.
 draw a Tic-Tac-Toe grid on the cardstock cut-out. There should be two vertical and horizontal lines each,
 equally spaced, for a total of nine squares/rectangles.
5. Using a marker, draw an " $X$ " on one set of painted pebbles and an " $O$ " on the other. Start playing, and store the pebbles in the box once you're done!
