· Share our success stories

 Share a framework to form similar groups

Step 1

- · Find a kindergarten or kindergartens that have similar philosophies.
- · Establish contact at the Principal level.
- Express your desire to collaborate (<u>win-win</u> situation)
- · Build trust and bond through regular meetings or interactions.

Step 2

 Look at a common non-threatening activity to experience or share.

Step 3
