Brief Description

- “Treasures” of play are found in the different compartments of the tool cart that cater to children’s interest and inquiry topic.
- Outdoor learning experiences will vary from class to class.
- Teachers can transport equipment and resources outdoor with ease and convenience for teaching and learning.

Objectives

- To nurture our children to be confident by harnessing their natural curiosity as they explore different spaces and equipment.
- To encourage innovative and creative thinking and equip children with life-skills such as taking initiative and helping out.
- To work collaboratively and interact respectfully with others.

Processes

- Exploring and designing the tool cart.
- Engaging a specialist/trainer to equip teachers with the knowledge and skills to facilitate outdoor learning for children.

Outcomes & Impact

- Replicated the tool cart with our partner centres.
- The cart was also used as a music wagon to transport instruments to the Eldercare centre for a sing-along session.
- Centre is actively using the cart for daily outdoor exploration and learning.
