BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROJECT

The indoor learning environment was extended to include the outdoor space. The intention was to provide children with more learning opportunities to engage in purposeful play.

OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

- Refurbish the school's outdoor environment.
- Extend the indoor learning environment.
- To increase children's repertoire of purposeful play.



OUTCOMES AND IMPACT

- Children learn to negotiate, cooperate and respect each other.

- Conducted brainstorming sessions for ideas.
- Worked with teachers to design the outdoor learning space and set up learning centres.
- Discussions with children on the different learning centres.
- Gathered feedback and learning points from teachers and children.
- Conducted critical review with the Project Team.
- Developed strategies to further improve the outdoor learning centres.

- Resources changed regularly to sustain children's interest and engagement.
- Recycled materials or donated articles are used to reduce financial burden.
