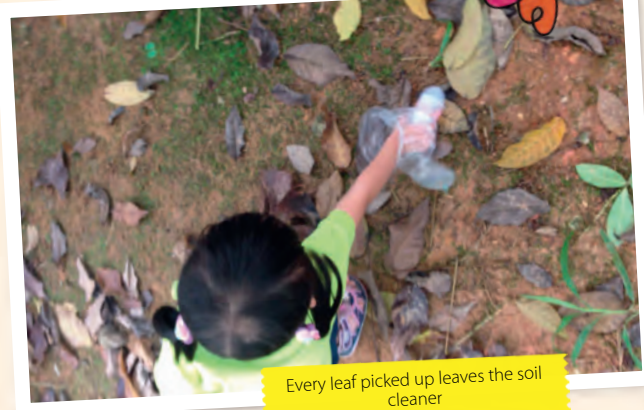

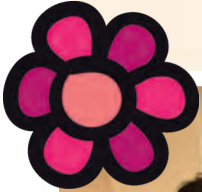
With the help of their teachers, the children took great care of the plants and anticipated their growth. Each day, a new shoot, a bud or a strong standing green plant gives them much excitement.

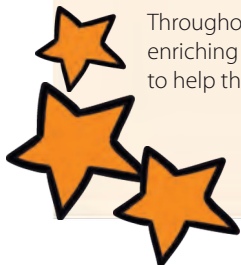
