**Dr Seuss Day:
Dr Seuss Hat**

MATERIALS:

Books by Dr Seuss
Paper plates
White drawing paper (A3)
Red Duct Tape or
Red Paint
Paint Brushes
Scissors

Adults should supervise the children when carrying out these activities.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Introduce Dr Seuss Day to the children by reading his story books.
2. Introduce iconic Dr Seuss Hat to the children and the materials provided.
3. Demonstrate how to make the hat.
4. Cut a hole in the plate.
5. Paste red duct tape or paint bold red stripes on the drawing paper.
6. Roll paper horizontally and tape the ends.
7. Cut short vertical lines at the bottom.
8. Place rolled paper on top of plate so it forms a hat.
9. Allow the children to use the hat to reenact Dr Seuss stories or encourage them to bring a book from home to share.
