




Celebrating Singapore's 57th birthday!

How to use this book

Show this love by drawing out their family on page 16 and sharing it with their classmates! They can also talk about their own visits to different places in Singapore as they complete the word search puzzle on page 15. Finally, there are simple art and craft activities that children can make in school or at home to be part of our nation's birthday celebrations - make a clothespin airplane to join in the fly-past or the Singapore flag to wave while watching the parade on 9 August!

Most of all, I always put my family first and take joy in showing the family values of love, care and concern, commitment and respect to them.




















Family Activities

This year for National Day, what good deed do you aspire to do with your family?






