tree Chloe loves.





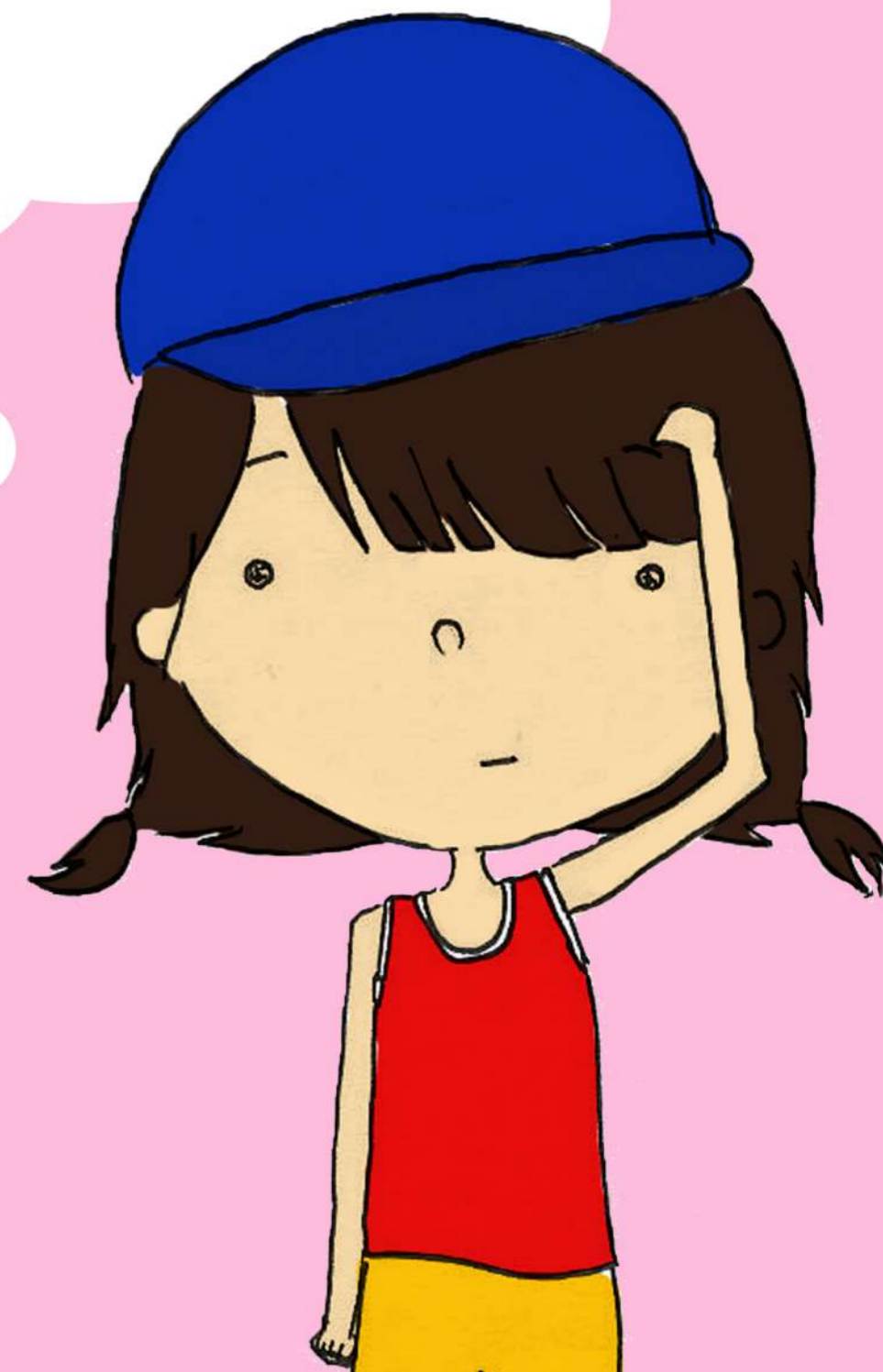
Chloe loves the

so it will not feel hot.

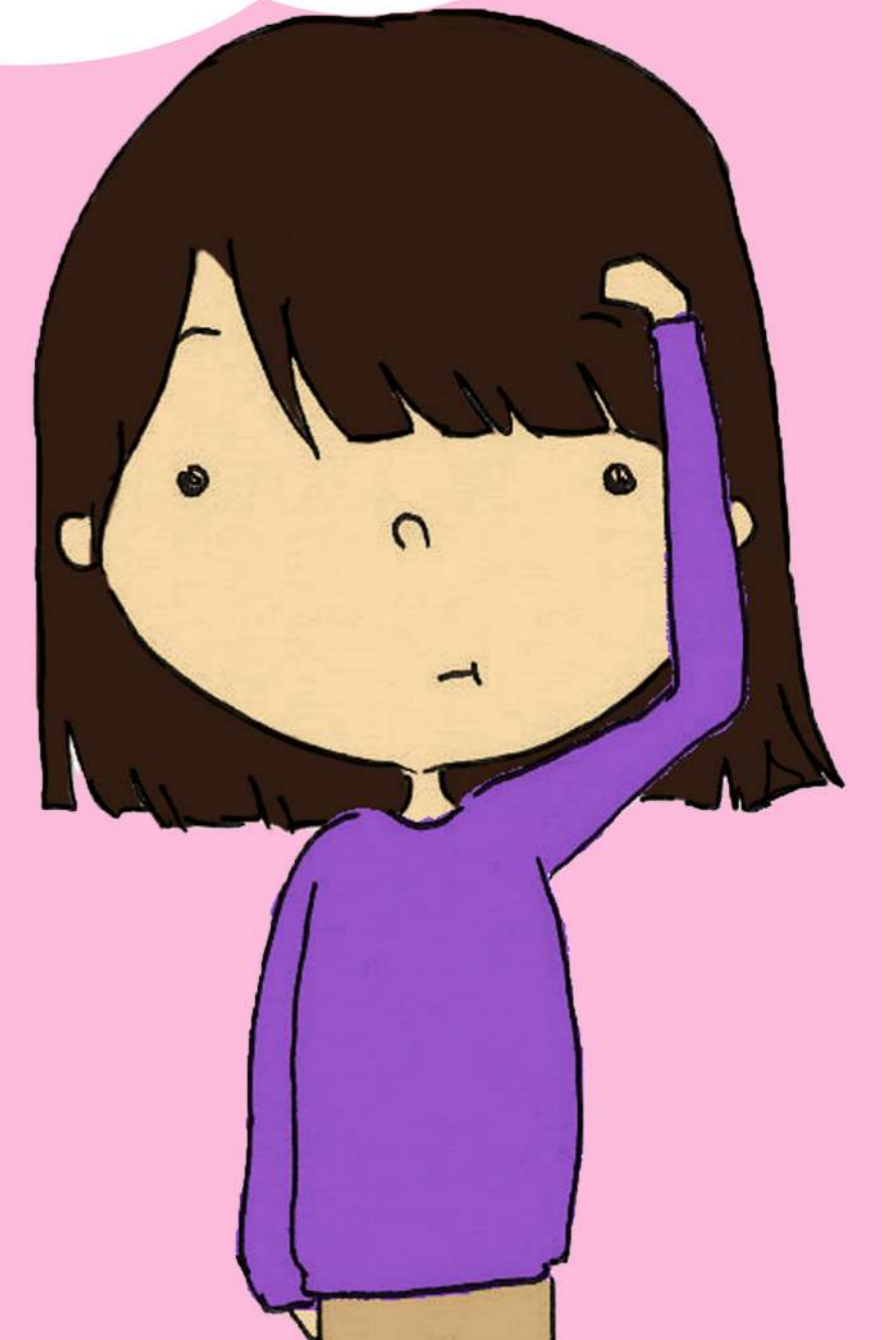


But she still misses the tree in spring.

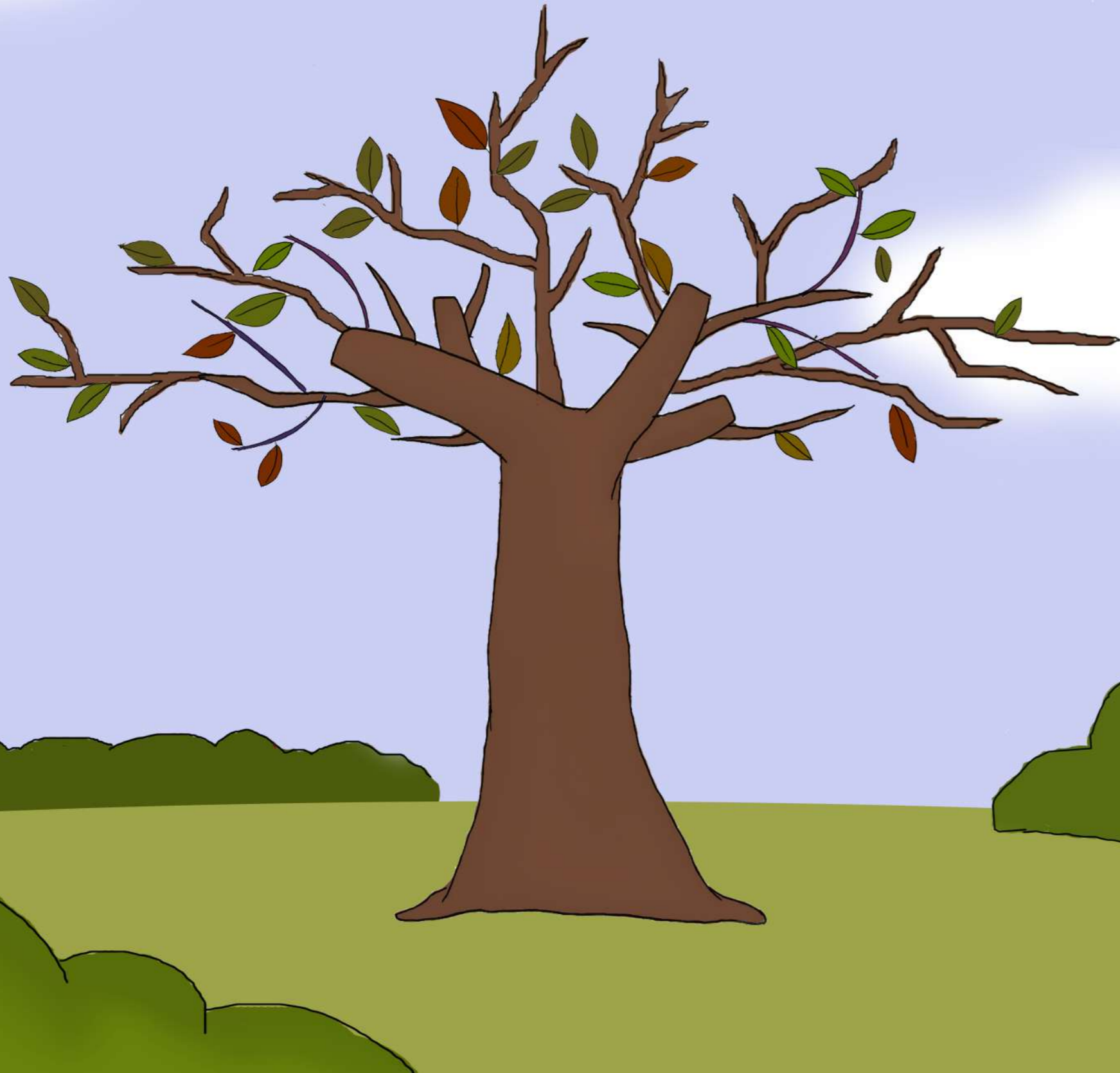

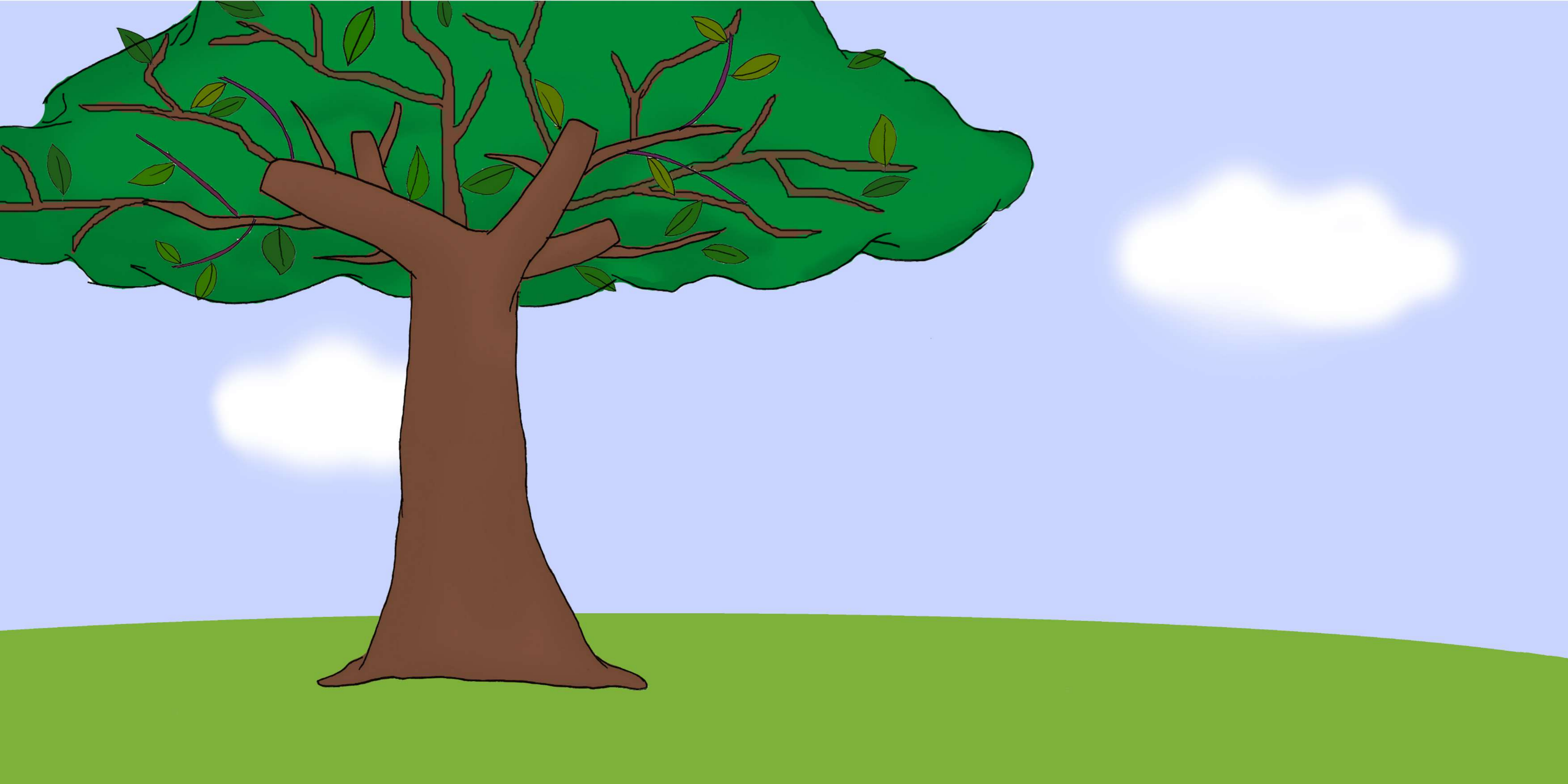

And there is the

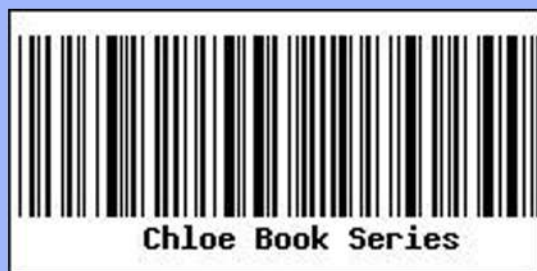

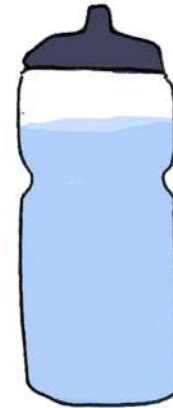
