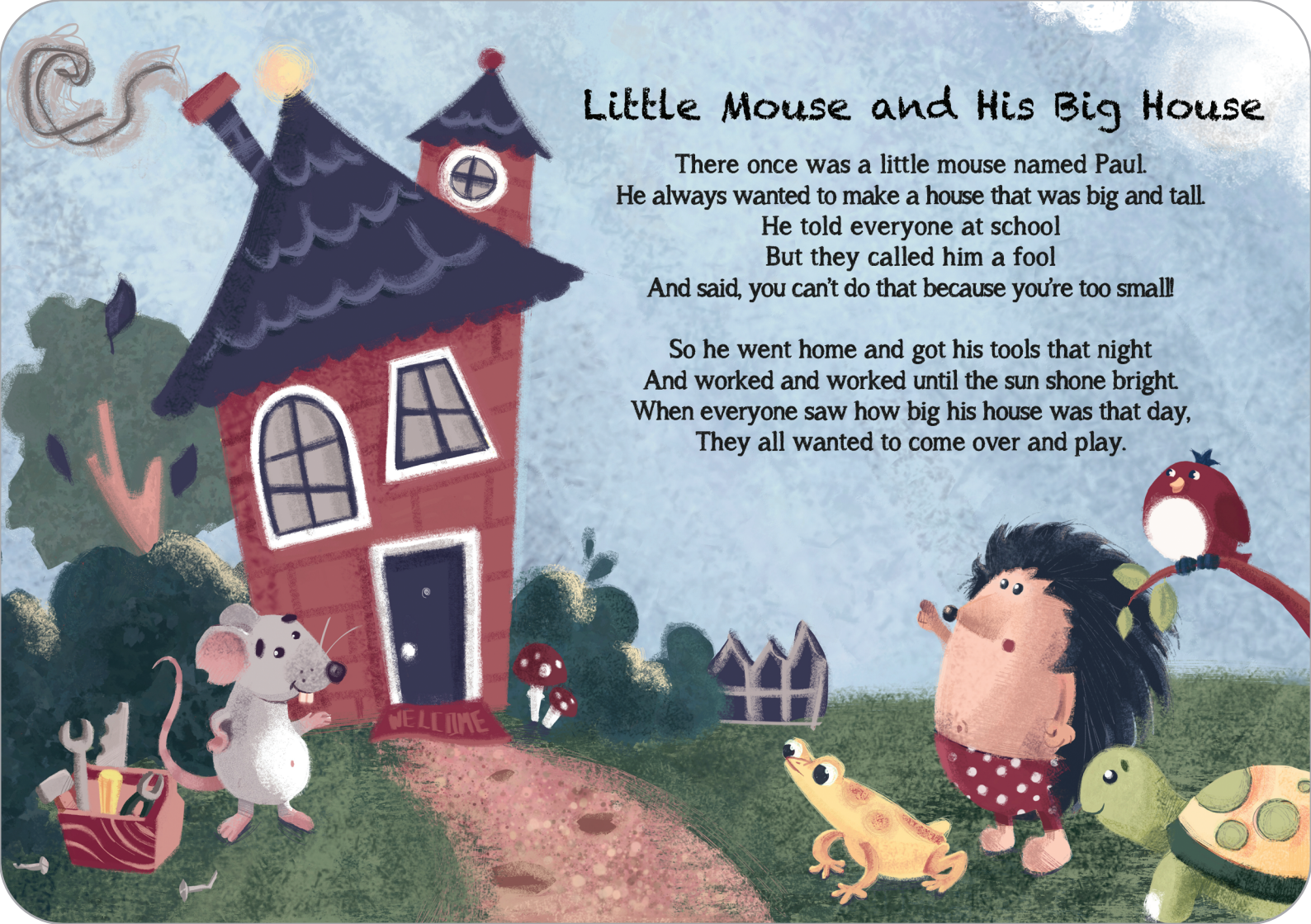


Little Mouse and His Big House

FUN THINGS TO DO WITH YOUR CHILD

2. Discuss questions like "I wonder if Paul was hurt by his friends' unkind remarks?", "Why do you think Paul did not let these remarks stop him from building his house?" and "I wonder if Paul will let his friends play in his new house?".
3. Make a house using materials you can find at home such as shoe boxes, old T-shirts, magazines and newspapers.
